Broadway Armory

The EGA Board thanks those who provided aid to migrants at the Broadway Armory Park, including individuals, organizations, and the Alder's staff. Now that the mayor's office has begun the process of transitioning the Park back to normal programming, we are committed to working with the park advisory council and park staff to restore programming and participation to pre-pandemic levels.

School Board Elections

In November, Chicago residents will vote for school board members. The new school board subdistricts do not reflect ward boundaries, and the election process is somewhat complex. These positions are important as CPS faces a \$600M structural deficit and the school board is considering big changes, including some that may impact the selective enrollment model that allows students to attend schools outside of their neighborhoods. We have included a few resources to help you prepare for the election, including a link to upcoming CPS community forums. The EGA Board will investigate options for surveying candidates and offering chances to meet them ahead of the upcoming election.
